

South India Birds and Mammals Tour with Wild About Travel 2nd - 15th February 2010

2nd Flight with Emirates

3rd Bangalore - Mysore Arrived (Bangalore) and met up with our guide mid morning. Drove to Mysore, checked in and spent the last 2 hours of the day at Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary.

4th Mysore - Nagarhole. Left hotel 07.15 hrs for drive of 2 hrs + 1 hr stopping en route for bird watching. Arrived at Kabini River Lodge at 10.30 hrs, explored the grounds from 11.15 - 13.00 hrs, then took 16.0 hrs safari into Nagarhole NP. Arrived back at about 19.00 hrs.

5th Nagarhole. Wake-up call 06.00 hrs and left on jeep safari at 06.45hrs returning at 10.30 hrs. Some bird watching around the grounds midday, then an afternoon boat trip from 16.00 till 18.40 hrs.

6th Nagarhole - Ooty. Breakfast at 06.30 and way by 06.50 hrs stopping en route to Ooty for birding at road side interesting habitats, then for a few hours in the afternoon (from 13.30 - 16.45 hrs) in arid scrub habitat 7 - 10km Ooty side of Nest Inn. Arrived in Ooty around 18.00 hrs.

7th Ooty area. Land adjacent to Fernhill Palace Hotel (07.30 - 08.50 hrs), then spent a while at Doddapetta View Point and some other areas of forest returning to hotel for lunch at 12.15 hrs. Train journey in afternoon didn't produce very many species!

8th Ooty - Topslip. Left around 07.30 hrs birding along the way to Topslip. Arrived at Lodge for lunch, then afternoon birding in scrub and forest habitat on the boundary of Anamalai NP till dusk (18.30 - 18.45 hrs)

9th Ooty - Chinnar Wildlife Sanctuary - Munnar. Left around 07.00 - 07.15 hrs. Arrived at Chinnar at 10.00 hrs staying till 12.30 hrs. Continued on to Munnar area stopping for good quality shola forest habitat for birding. Arrived at hotel 18.00 hrs.

10th Munnar area. Left at 07.25 hrs in the direction of Bodimettu Road taking a packed lunch with us. Returned around 18.00 hrs.

11th Munnar area. Left at 07.00 hrs and walked down the road past turning for Portha Madu (hill) returning around 11.30 hrs. Time in Munnar town, then to Karadippara Tea Shack for birding end of afternoon from around 16.00 - 18.00 hrs.

12th Munnar - Thattekad. Left at 07.25 hrs arrived at Karadippara Tea Shack at 08.05 where we spent about 1/2 hr birding before continuing our journey (2 hrs) to Thattekad. Birding around resort middle of day, then out into plantation and wetland habitats around Cochin Airport Signalling station, then a small puddle at edge of Thattekad Bird Sanctuary for last 3 hrs of daylight.

13th Thattekad area. Had earlier breakfast because of heat. Left before daybreak arriving in good forest habitat for 06.30 hrs. Visited a second forest area and then spent some time by the Periyar River till about 11.30 hrs. Out again at 15.30 hrs visiting habitat by the River Periyar and walked a forest trail adjacent to wetland area for the remainder of the day, finishing the walk in darkness.

14th Thattekad area. Left lodge at 06.30 hrs and spend most of the morning in Thattekad Bird Sanctuary (closed for previous week due to elephant activity). Middle of day around lodge, then out again at 15.30 hrs in suitable habitat for owls and nightjars.

15th Thattekad - Cochin (Kochi) for return flight home. Most of journey was in darkness as our flight left at 09.30 hrs, so no birding on this day.

271 species of birds seen + 4 heard only. 15 species of mammals seen + reptiles and amphibians.
